4. Reports

A. Crown

1. Citizenship issue. Sir Garahan appointed. Still gathering information.

B. Heirs

1. Coronation - May 3, 2014, Bloomington, IN. Shire of Mynydd Seren. Steward: Warder Peter Grau von Bremen. Confirm approval. Approved.

2. Crown - May 24-25, 2014, Tipton, IN. Barony of Sternfeld. Stewards: Mistress Moira MacGillavrey and Mistress Wulfwen atte Belle. Confirm approval. Approved.

C. KMoAS

1. Midrealm RUM report. 120 classes, 400+ people attended. Made a profit, including covering the \$0.50 per person fee and \$500 allocation.
2. New A&S Criteria. Confections posted to email list. Everyone liked it.
3. New MOAS Handbook. No comments, proceed with using it.

D. KEM

1. Coursing Guild issue. Is in contact, and will have something by Baron Wars to get them into the Marshallate, probably sooner (March).
2. Reporting - Domesday 2013. All in and complete. Sir Bran is special deputy for getting reports in on time.
3. New Handbooks – Youth, Rapier, Armored, and Equestrian to be rewritten. Archery handbook is fantastic and is being used throughout the Known World.
4. New Rapier Earl Marshal – Will step up on Val Day, we have good candidates.
5. New Youth Policies – Suggestions from Kazmir. Get rid of Division IV (because they can fight as adults). For 16&17, an adult now won't need to be present. Advanced authorization for anyone to allow them to fight with the youth (this is not automatic with Knighthood). The Society Deputy for Youth Combat is for these changes too. Note that youth will still have their own cards until they are 18; in this way it will be clear to the list table that they are different.
6. New Deputies for Reporting (Bran) and Web design (still looking).
7. Cut and Thrust – HRH is promoting this. Society Earl Marshal is allowing us to experiment with grappling. Another proposal is out there for competitive wrestling.
8. Combat Archery Marshal Designation – No one has been designated to inspect archery gear. Master Erikson (deputy) is putting a program into place (starting very soon).

E. K Chron

1. Kingdom Webminister items
 - i. Status of migration - put on hold while we are finding a Project Manager
 - ii. Project Manager Selection. We have one candidate. Will get an updated resume and interview him by phone (KChron and KSen)
2. Status of Baronial quarterly news letters. More has been done, training is still happening. Only one or two are missing newsletters (down from half not doing it).
3. Search is on for new editor of the Pale. Gunner has some candidates.

4. MK Chronicler Handbook approval. It is updated. Approved.
5. Unofficial Kingdom Blog discussion. Similar idea to what is being done by the East Kingdom. News stories and such. He will move forward with it and see what happens.

F. KHer

1. Term of office ends at Spring Coronation. Two candidates that can do the job. Requesting more candidates (Feb Pale). Decision by March. Aiming for Spring Coronation.
2. Dragon Signet change. Some discussion occurred.

G. K Chir

1. Applications for Kingdom Chirurgeon. One applicant, will determine when switchover will occur.
2. North Oaken Chirurgeon: South Oaken will take over for both Regions.
3. Report sent to Society Chirurgeon. Not heard back yet.

H. KExch

1. Status of groups in financial probation – none! However, heading into Domesday.
2. Introducing Aelfric, next KExch. Warrant expires in May.
3. Approval of Seneschal and Exchequer Symposium budget: \$2,000. Midair, Brianna, and AElfric are going.

I. KSen

1. Permanent Site for Coronations and Crowns. Dropping. We are keeping the door open for applications in case something great comes along, but Curia isn't sure that multi-years are something we should institute.
2. Deputies
 - i. North Oaken Regional, replaced Eidiard An Gobhainn with Lazaro de Toledo (Clarke Andrade).
3. Groups
 - i. Tirnewydd (Columbus, OH) problem. In the past month they received a bill from Worthington City School Board for \$5,580 (31 days X 4 hours X \$45/hr. It was an increase from \$15 to \$45 per hour. They have retained

the services of Mr. Kelly Parks (pro-bono), who will negotiate the final bill. Ongoing. HRM has an update. Issue has been resolved by the group satisfactorily. The bill is a reduced amount (\$3,300), but the site has gotten so expensive they won't be using it again. Resolved.

- ii. Cynnabar sent in a request to review their zip codes. Count Savaric is working on recommendations for Pentamere's border issues. There should be an updated by Maidens (25 January).

4. Law changes

- i. Remove Court of Chivalry stuff from Kingdom Law. Law change printed in Pale and posted online. Discussed commentary. Instead of dropping it, we will look into replacing it. KSen volunteered to come up with a replacement law.
- ii. Work on changing Kingdom Law IX-100 so Territorial Barons in their Barony are above Peerages, and below outside of their Land. Feedback from Royal Peers. Status? Discussed commentary. TRMs will make a decision on this.

- 5. Requested that Minister of Youth and Law Clerk organize all the laws and rules governing minors. Ongoing. Excellent updates have been received, and KSen will continue to push for a resolution so we can move forward with fixes.
