

## 2019 REGIONAL AND KINGDOM A&S FAIRE RULES

- Entries will be judged using the new criteria.
- Judging will be done face-to-face if possible. Entrants can request written scored judging or comments only judging.
- All entrants will receive their comment and scores at the event they are judged. If there are questions regarding comments and scores, please let the Regional MoAS at the Regional Faires or the Kingdom MoAS at the Kingdom Faires know before site closes the day of judging. After that day, the entrant would then need to send a copy of all three score sheets to the appropriate Regional MoAS
- We will not be awarding first, second, and third places.
- If someone submits a non-Pentathlon entry, they should expect to help with the judging. Please advise let the Regional MoAS at the Regional Fairs or the Kingdom MoAS at the Kingdom fairs know if there is a problem with that expectation.
- Mail-in categories must be email by Midnight 4 weeks prior to the fair you are entering.
- The general rules are also in effect and can be found at a link on KMOAS website.
- Entrants are expected to not plagiarize; guidance on plagiarism can be can be found at a link on KMOAS website.

### Individual Entries: Regional Faires

- The five entries in each region with the highest score will be announced in alphabetical order. This excludes entries associated with winning Pentathlon and winning Divisionals
- Non-Pentathlon entries can be entered into any Regional Faire.

### Divisional entries:

- There will be Divisional Champions for 2019 Faire.
- Each contestant will be allowed only one Divisional entry consisting of no more than three entries.

All entries used in a Regional Divisional Championship must score higher than 19 points to be eligible to participate at the Kingdom Arts and Sciences Champion

### Pentathlon Entries: Regional Faires

- Each contestant will be allowed only one Pentathlon entry consisting of no more than five entries.
- The contestant must have scores in five categories drawn from at least four separate divisions, with entries in no more than two categories in any one division.
- All entries used in a regional Pentathlon championship must score higher than 19 points to be eligible to participate at the Kingdom Pentathlon Championship.

- Pentathlons must be entered into the entrant's home region's faire.
- The top scoring Pentathlon will be named as the Regional A&S Champion.

#### Kingdom Faire

- The Kingdom Faire will be limited to fifty individual and divisional entries and to five Pentathlon entries.

All entries to come to Kingdom must score 19 or above

- The top scoring Pentathlon from each region will advance to the Kingdom Faire, provided that all five entries meet the minimum score requirement.

The top scoring Divisional entry in each Division will be announced

- For individual entries, at the Regional Faire, 30% of the total # of entries progress to Kingdom after subtracting the number of pentathlon and divisional winners from the total
- At the Kingdom Faire, the top three non-Pentathlon scoring pieces in each Division will be announced.
- A Pentathlon entry that did not qualify for the Kingdom Faire may have its component entries changed to individual entries and have them entered into the pool for advancement to the Kingdom Faire as individual entries.
- At the Kingdom Faire the Pentathlon entries will be announced in reverse order (highest score announced last).
